Red Planet Day Wednesday 28 November 2018

The planet Mars referred to as the "**Red Planet**" because it appears red in color. Red Planet Day honors our celestial neighbor, the fourth planet in the solar system. Red Planet Day commemorates the launch of the Spacecraft Mariner 4 on 28 November 1964. The 228-solar Earth day mission of Mariner 4 brought the spacecraft within 9846 kilometers of Mars.

Marstellers of Wilmington, North Carolina

GEORGE L. MARSTELLER, of N Jacobi & Co., bds at Mrs. deBebian, 1865

LEWIS EDWIN MARSTELLER, born 4 February 1839 to Lewis H. & Lavinia Marsteller, baptized 15 March 1839 at St. James Episcopal Church, Wilmington. Sadly died and buried the next day 16 March 1839.

LEWIS HEISKEL MARSTELLER, born 6 November 1804 in Alexandria, Virginia. Married Lavinia H. Geer at St. James, Wilmington on 11 May 1826. Died 3 March 1860 buried in Oakdale Cemetery, Wilmington.

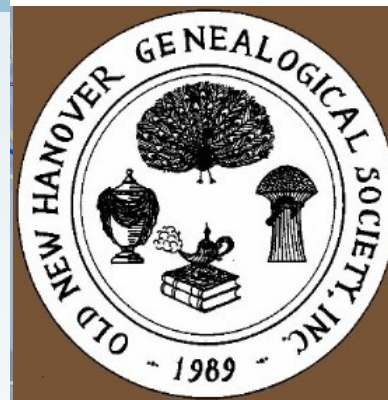
REBECCA MARSTELLER, born 12 August 1858 to John & Caroline Marsteller, baptized at St. James, 16 June 1859.

RICHARD SPAIGHT MARSTELLER, born to Lewis H. & Lavinia Marsteller, baptized 24 April 1836 at St. James Church, Wilmington. Died in August 1838 and buried 30 August 1838.

VIRGINIA E. MARSTELLER, born 5 July 1834 to Lewis & Lavinia Marsteller, baptized 12 April 1835 at St. James Church, Wilmington. Married Samuel R. Bunting 16 October 1855. Died 30 April 1914 and buried in Oakdale Cemetery.

WILLIAM HOWARD & ANNA JANE MARSTELLER, baptized at St. James Church, Wilmington, on 9 June 1850, children of John Marsteller - - Also Edwin Drane Marsteller, baptized 2 June 1852, and child of John Marsteller. John Marsteller married to Susan Howe, 4 March 1839 at St. James Church. The parish register indicates the family as *free Black persons*. Mrs. M later identified as Caroline.

WILMER MARSTELLER, born to Lewis H. & Lavinia Marsteller, baptized 27 November 1831 at St. James Church, Wilmington. Died in August 1838 and buried 30 August 1838.

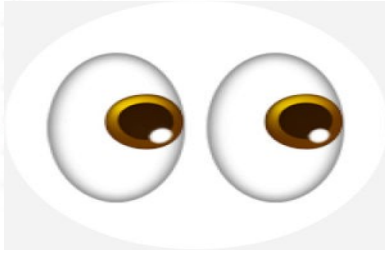

Overlooked marriages & deaths notices

Abstracts from the Wilmington Journal weekly 1844-1847, a continuing series from the previous Clarendon Courier. These notices identified as OVERLOOKED after discovering them left out from other publications featuring mid-19th century Wilmington newspapers.

Wilmington Journal weekly Friday 7 November 1845 page 3

MARRIED—In this town, on Monday evening last, by the Rev. **Thomas Murphy**, **Henry W. Groves**, formerly of St. Augustine, E. Fla., to Miss **Julia A. Halsey**, of this town.

DIED—In Sampson county, on the evening of the 1st inst., near Clinton, Mrs. **Bunting**, wife of Dr. **Thos. Bunting**.

D—In Sampson county, on the 20th ultimo, **Elizabeth Penelope**, aged four years, daughter of Dr. **Thomas Bunting**.

Wilmington Journal weekly Friday 14 November 1845 page 3

MARRIED— In Columbus county, near Whiteville, by **J. S. Baldwin** Esq., on the 30th ult., Mr. **Wm. Millican**, to Miss **Sarah Pridgen**, formerly of Green county.

DIED—In Duplin county, on the morning of the 31st October, Mr. **Wm. Carr**, aged 49 years, 8 months and 2 days.

Seldom are we called upon to record a death so much to be deplored as the above.

D—In this county, at his residence on Burgaw, after a severe illness of 5 weeks, Mr. **H. G. Cowan**, aged 61 years.

D—In Cumberland county, on Thursday the 23d ult., Mrs. **Martha McLaurin**, wife of **Thomas McLaurin**, aged 48 years.

Wilmington Journal weekly Friday 21 November 1845 page 3

MARRIED— In Fayetteville, on the 12th inst., by the Rev. **Jas. McDaniel**, Rev. **John Brantly**, of Raleigh, to Miss **Philadelphia Smith**.

DIED—In this town, on the 11th inst., Mrs. **Caroline** Russell, wife of **Daniel L. Russell**, Esq., of Brunswick County, and daughter of **David W. Saunders**, Esq., of Onslow County, in the 20th year of her age.

D—Near Clinton, Sampson County, on the 6th inst., Mr. **Street Ashford**.

Wilmington Journal weekly Friday 28 November 1845 page 3

MARRIED— In Fayetteville, on Wednesday evening the 19th inst., by Rev. **Adam Gilchrist**, Mr. **Robert W. Hardie**, to Miss **Mary Ann Rhodes**, all of Fayetteville.

M—In this town, on the 18th inst., by the Rev. **W. Martin**, **W. D. Smith**, to Miss **Margaret E. Gardner**.

DIED—In Duplin county, on the 18th inst., **Sena Eliza Davis**, aged thirteen years and seven months. Her illness was of short duration, but her sufferings were great, which she bore with much meekness, and seemed perfectly resigned to her fate.
